



Food labelling -FDA & BfR Regulations

The FDA and BfR are organisations which set standards for adhesives for food and medical use

Both the Food and Drug Administration, USA (FDA) and BfR (Bundesinstitut für Riskikoberwertung, or Federal Institute for Risk Assessment) in Germany publish lists of chemicals according to their food contact approvals. However, they do not carry out individual product approvals.

All of Zebra's standard paper products comply with FDA and BfR regulations for indirect food labeling.

Separate approvals exist for direct food labelling as shown in the table below.
